- Listen to students concerns about academic, emotional, and social problems
- Help students overcome their fears, concerns, or other issues

- Provide mental and behavioral counseling to students
- Conduct individual and group counseling sessions
- Identify academic struggles, or behavioral problems and meet with parents
- Create a plan or set goals for students to help them achieve their academic goals
- Be able to identify verbal or physical abuse and approach parents or proper authorities in regards to it
- Give workshops on bullying, drug abuse, depression, etc.
- Work collaboratively with all school staff to create a positive learning community
- Demonstrate ethical behaviour
- Create an environment that is inviting, respectful, supportive, inclusive, and flexible
