- **Outcome:** Improve critical thinking and media literacy.

5. Cultural Exhibition

- **Objective:** Showcase Palestinian thobes.
- **Instructions:** Research and create display boards on different aspects of thobes. Organize a classroom exhibition.
- **Outcome:** Develop research, presentation skills, and cultural appreciation.
